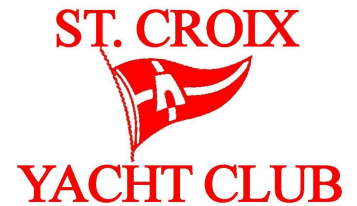

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

1.1 The races will be governed by the Sailing Rules of Racing, **Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) shall be worn by ALL sailors, no exceptions.**

1.2 Please give sail number and Name to the Race Committee at the End of the T-Dock

2 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

2.1 Signals made ashore will be announced verbally near the boats to be sailed.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1 **Friday Evenings:** 1630- 1700 -Beach Start
1715ish- until -Racing inside of the Mooring Field.

3.2 **Final Friday:** ***ASAP After Racing a Short Awards will be held.***

4 COURSE[S] and MARKS

4.1 Will be displayed on the Sailing Notice board in the West Hallway

5 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES; STARTING SYSTEM

5.1 The starting/Finish line will be on the starboard side of the RC boat and a finish pin. .

5.2 3 min Starting Sequence will be used

6 PENALTY SYSTEM

6.1 360° turn only.

7 PROTESTS and REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

7.1 Will be an open hearing after racing using five min. Justice.

8 SCORING & PRIZES

8.1 The great adventure of sailing and that you survived and are blessed to be able to sail in the caribbean.

8.2 For every six races there will be one throwout given.

8.3 Ribbons and Assorted Prizes will be awarded to the participants.

9 COMMUNICATION.

9.1 Gentle yelling on the course, inside voices in the Club house, hand gestures at distance.

10 RETIRING FROM RACING

10.1 Any sailor retiring from a race or for the day, please contact as many other sailors as possible and tell at least one person at the club if you decide to leave the SCYC
